## 3. Membership Requirements

The ATA Trade Show is a member-only event. In order to present at the Trade Show, you must be a current member and obtain a Trade Show badge through the registration process. ## 4. Purpose

The purpose of educational sessions at the ATA Trade Show is to give attendees valuable learning experiences that will benefit them as individuals and businesses. While educational sessions are NOT intended to be solicitation opportunities for products or services, they can and should be utilized to build relationships between current and prospective business partners.

## 5. Applications

Any current member organization or an affiliated individual may submit an application to present. Applications must be completed using the 2023 Call for Presenters form. Submissions are due by July 31, 2022. All submissions will be reviewed by ATA Staff.

Applicants for Seminars and Coffee Talks will be informed whether or not their submission has been accepted by Sept. 15, 2022.

## 6. Presentation Formats

- **Masterclass sessions** will be held the day before the Show on Jan. 10, 2023. Masterclass presenters are expected to deliver high-quality content with actionable takeaways for attendees. Masterclass presenters will be compensated.
- **Seminars** will be held the last two days of the Show, Jan. 12-13, 2023, from 8:00 a.m. - 9:15 a.m. Presenters are expected to arrive to their seminar rooms 15 minutes before their scheduled presentation time. Seminar rooms will be equipped with a screen, projector, and microphone. It is the responsibility of the presenter to supply attendees with handouts.
- **Coffee Talks** will be held throughout Show floor hours in the MyATA Area and will be scheduled for 30 minute or 60 minute time slots. Coffee Talk presenters will have a microphone and TV screen. Presenters are encouraged to use a discussion style format.
