


2021 STATE-BY-STATE BOWHUNTER NUMBERS



The ATA worked with state wildlife agencies and partners to determine bowhunter participation numbers in each state during the 2021-22 season. After combining the state totals, the ATA can confidently report America has over **3.7 MILLION LICENSED BOWHUNTERS.**
